



The 29th Summer Universiade Taipei 2017

The 29th Summer Universiade 2017 was held in Taipei, Taiwan from 19-30 August 2017. Second only in size to the Olympic Games, the Universiade attract over 10,000 competitors and officials from over 150 countries. Hong Kong sent a Delegation of around 160 student athletes and officials to compete in 14 sporting events including Archery, Artistic Gymnastics, Athletics, Badminton, Men's Basketball, Fencing, Golf, Roller Sports, Swimming, Table Tennis, Taekwondo, Tennis, Men's Volleyball and Wushu. It is the biggest Delegation that we have ever sent to the Summer Universiade since our presence in the event held in Japan in 1985.

All athletes, coaches and officials' contribution and efforts making the participation in the Taipei Summer Universiade a success. This was the best ever results of Hong Kong, China among all the Universiade.

The highlighted results:

- Miss Siobhan Bernadette HAUGHEY won Gold medals for Women's 100M & 200M Freestyle events and broke the Games record in 200M Freestyle.
- Mr. WONG Chun Hun and Mr. YEUNG Pak Long won Bronze medal for Men's Tennis Doubles event.
- Miss MOK Uen Ying Juanita won Bronze medal for Women's Wushu (Taolu Taijiquan & Taijijian) event.
