



2025 - 2026 年度大專羽毛球比賽

一、賽制

- (a) 如參加之單位只有六隊或以下，將採用單循環比賽。倘參加之單位有七隊或以上，則採用分組單循環比賽，以最佳成績之兩隊參加準決賽及決賽。每組第三，四名順序參加名次賽，全部採用交叉淘汰制。
- (b) 每場比賽五盤，以先勝三盤者為勝，每盤採取三局二勝制，每局採廿一分直接得分制進行比賽。
- (c) 比賽次序：(1) 第一單打 (2) 第二單打 (3) 第一雙打 (4) 第二雙打 (5) 第三單打。
- (d) 每一球員在每場比賽中祇能參加一盤單打及一盤雙打比賽。
- (e) 第一單打及第二單打之球員不能參加該隊之第一雙打。

二、規則

除賽會特別訂明外，其他規則一律參考最新（該年度九月份）世界羽毛球聯會（Badminton World Federation – BWF）編訂之規則。

三、計分方法

- (a) 單循環比賽勝一場得 2 分，負一場得 1 分，棄權或被取消資格得 0 分。
- (b) 倘積分相同時，兩隊同分隊伍以勝者為勝。倘三隊或以上積分相同，首先計算有關隊伍相互比賽勝場次數多者名次列前。如勝場次數相同，則計算相關隊伍的對賽成績，勝者為勝。如仍未能分出勝負，則計算相關隊伍盤數之勝負差，多者名次列前。若仍未能分出勝負，則計算相關隊伍局數之勝負差，多者名次列前。倘再相同則計算相關隊伍每局分數之勝負差，多者名次列前（計算公式：勝負差 = 得盤 / 局 / 分 - 失盤 / 局 / 分）。
- (c) 倘結果仍然相同，則由有關隊伍重賽（此項只適用於出線隊伍產生之情況下）。

四、報名

- (a) 每院校限報男女子各一隊，運動員經填報後相片不得更改，報名表須經院校董事局成員簽署及蓋上院校印鑑。
- (b) 凡報名表內相片吻合之運動員，其報名表上填寫之中、英文姓名或身份證號碼（英文字母及首四位數字）。有個別錯字出現或有相片互相錯貼者，可給予更正，准予參賽；但報名表上姓名及身份證位置貼錯「其他人」之相片時，而該「其他人」之相片經核對後，在報名表上並無相關姓名或身份證資料者與之符合，則有關運動員之報名宣告無效，不符合出賽資格。
- (c) 每隊報名人數不得超過十人及不得少於四人。
- (d) 合資格參賽年齡為1990年1月1日至2008年12月31日。

五、改期

賽程經主委編定後，各院校不得要求改期。若有特別事故，主委有權更改賽期。

六、裁判

由比賽主委聘請合格裁判擔任，惟出賽隊伍須負責派出司線員（熟識球例者），協助裁判工作。

七、棄權

- (a) 球賽進行之任何爭議，倘已明文規定者或有同等意義註明者，由裁判判定，不得異議。比賽須繼續進行，如有隊伍放棄繼續比賽，作棄權論。
- (b) 棄權隊伍均須就棄權一事作書面解釋（比賽後七十二小時內 *假期計算在內）。該書面信函須由院校董事局成員簽署。

八、抗議及上訴

賽後如有抗議提出上訴者，應在賽後七十二小時內（假期計算在內）以書面提出。該書面信函須由院校董事局成員簽署，連同保證金港幣參仟圓，送交比賽主委提出上訴，經由上訴委員會審判後為最終判決。

九、天氣

如開賽前2小時，香港天文台已發出八號或以上熱帶氣旋警告信號之預警、八號或以上熱帶氣旋警告信號或黑色暴雨警告信號，當日全部賽事將取消，主委將另行安排補賽。協辦院校場地設施在惡劣天氣訊號下的開放安排：

十、 附則

- (a) 採用“C.N. Alpha Gold Label Speed: 77”羽毛球；賽會將提供比賽用球；所有贊助用球（包括全新和比賽用過的）必須於當日比賽完成後歸還賽會。
- (b) 各隊隊員須穿著所屬隊伍的同色同款比賽服。
- (c) 教練席上人士必為教練本人或教練授權人士；教練授權人士必須於賽前由教練向主委申報。
- (d) 為免賽事延誤，如有必要，主委有權在有足夠裁判和場地的條件下，可要求參賽隊伍同時進行兩盤賽事。
- (e) 如有球員須連場比賽的情況下，休息時間不多於三十分鐘。
- (f) 為響應環保，本賽會將不會提供樽裝水。城大及恒生大學場地設有水機提供飲用水，請各院校提醒球員及教練自備水樽。
- (g) 本章程如有未盡善之處，主辦單位得隨時修訂，並提交大專執委會通過後實施。

2025-2026 USFHK Badminton Competition

1. Competition System

- a. A single round-robin system will be adopted in the preliminary round if there are only 6 participating teams. If there are more than 6 participating teams, the teams will be drawn into two groups. The top two teams in each group will qualify for the finals. Teams finishing at 3rd and 4th places in the groups will play the consolation round and the cross-elimination system will be adopted.
- b. A tie consists of the best of five matches. A match consists of the best of three games of 21 points by the rally point system.
- c. Order of play: (i) first Singles (ii) second Singles (iii) first Doubles (iv) second Doubles (v) third Singles.
- d. Each player in each tie can only participate in one Singles and one Doubles.
- e. First Singles and second Singles players cannot participate in the first Doubles.

2. Regulations

Unless otherwise stated, rules of the latest edition released annually in September by the Badminton World Federation (BWF) will be served as a reference.

3. Scoring

- a. 2 points will be scored upon winning a tie in the single round robin competition, 1 point for the loser side, and 0 point for abstaining or disqualification.
- b.
 - i. If two teams have won with the same points, the winner of the tie between them will be ranked higher.
 - ii. If three or more teams have won with the same points, the ranking will be established by the total ties won, with the team winning more ties ranked higher.
 - iii. If the total number of ties won are the same, the ranking will be established by the differences between the total number of matches won and total number of matches lost; the team with a greater difference will be ranked higher.
 - iv. If the winner is still undecided at this point, the ranking will be established by the differences between the total number of games won and total number of games lost; the team with the greater difference will be ranked higher.
 - v. If the winner remains undecided, the ranking will be established by the differences between the total points won and total points lost in each game; the team with the greater difference will be ranked higher. (Calculating formula: difference between won & lost = matches / games / points won – matches / games / points lost).
- c. If the result is still the same, a re-match for the teams concerned will be arranged. (This applies only in the case of teams advancing to the next round.)

4. Entries

- a. Each institution is limited to entering one men's team and one women's team.

- b. As long as the photo on the enrollment form match with the identity of the enrolled athlete, any amendment of typos of the athletes' Chinese name, English name or the Hong Kong Identity Card Number (The first alphabet and the first 4 digital figures) are acceptable; the concerned athlete can continue to compete after the amendment. If the photo on the enrollment form does not match the identity of the athlete enrolled, the enrollment of that athlete will be declared invalid, and the athlete concerned will be disqualified.
- c. The enrollment form must be signed by a Council Member of the USFHK and the institution's seal on the cover.
- d. Each team can enroll a maximum of 10 players and a minimum of 4 players.
- e. All players must be born between 1st January 1990 and 31th December 2008.

5. Rescheduling

After the competition fixture has been confirmed by the convenor, request for rescheduling will not be entertained. Under special circumstances, the convenor has the right to change the fixture.

6. Umpires

Convenor will employ qualified umpires for judging services, but the competing team is responsible for sending line judges who are familiar with the rules to assist the judging services.

7. Withdrawal

- a. Any team who fails to meet the minimum number players required for a particular game (minimum of 4 players at the USFHK Annual Badminton Competition) at the scheduled competition start time (according to the clock at the stadium) will be disqualified for the match.
- b. In case of a dispute, the decision of the referee made according to the relevant rules of badminton will be final. Should a team oppose the decision and refuse to play, the team will be taken as withdrawing from the match.
- c. The team disqualified as specified in 7(a) above should submit an official explanation signed by a Council Member of the institution concerned to the Chairman of the Executive Committee of the USFHK within 72 hours (irrespective of holidays) of the event.

8. Protests and Appeals

Appeals must be made in writing within 72 hours after the game (holidays included). The written appeal must be signed by a member of the Council Member, together with a deposit of One Thousand Hong Kong Dollars. All appeals must be sent to the Convenor of the event, and the decision of the Appeal Committee will be final.

9. Weather Conditions

If, two hours before the start of competitions/events, the Hong Kong Observatory issues a No. 8 or higher tropical cyclone warning signal or its pre-warning, or a black rainstorm warning signal, all competitions/events for that day will be canceled, and the convenor will arrange for rescheduling.

10. By-laws and Rules

- a. The "CN Alpha Gold Label, Speed:77" shuttlecocks are used in the competition; the convener will provide the competition shuttlecocks on each competition day. All sponsored shuttlecocks, either new or used, must be returned to the convener after each competition.
- b. **All team members must wear the team's competition uniform. The uniform must be in the same colour and pattern.**
- c. The person(s) sitting on the coach bench must either be the coach or a person authorized by the coach. The coach should introduce the authorized person to the convener before the event.
- d. To avoid any delay, if necessary, the convener has the right to require teams to have two matches at the same time provided that there are adequate and available referees and courts.
- e. If a player is involved in two consecutive matches, the rest periods should not last more than 30 minutes.
- f. Water fountain is available at the competition venue of the CityUHK and HSUHK, please bring your own bottles to refill with water if needed.
- g. If there are inadequacies in this Constitution, the organiser can amend it any time and submit it to the Executive Committee for approval before the adoption of the implementation.
